## Get Your Spring Clean On!

It's that time of year again...yes, time to Spring Clean! In this edition of Kleening News we're going to offer several tips and tricks you can utilize to make your spring cleanup more successful. First of all, clean your sink! Many find it hard to believe, however, your kitchen sink has more bacteria than your toilet seat!! Use an EPA registered disinfectant to clean the sink. Take care of the oven...line the bottom with a non-stick oven liner. Disinfect the garbage disposal. Drop in a cut-up lemon to get rid of odors. Then drop in ice and salt to clean away residue. KPS TOP TIP: Go microfiber! For most house cleaning paper towels are a waste. Microfiber can be re-used, sanitize floors, counters, glass and tile. Sponges are very popular but are a breeding ground for bacteria. Be sure to thoroughly rinse it out each evening and it's preferred that you put it in the microwave (on high) for one minute. Use bedtime as 'clean-time.' Just prior to getting in bed pick up miscellaneous items not taken

care of before days end. Store brooms with the handle down. It prolongs the life of the broom and allows you to more easily select the broom you want. Pick the proper dust pan! Those with a rubber edge are usually the most effective. In the bedroom, start with the bed! A made bed makes a room look much cleaner. Make it first thing each day. Dresser drawers are usually filled with clothing or items rarely worn or used. Get rid of the stuff you don't use anymore. Since fabric softener and dryer sheets can strip towels of their absorbency, add ¼ cup white vinegar to the rinse cycle or throw two (new, clean) tennis balls in your dryer to get rid of static electricity, soften fabrics and eliminate the need for dryer sheets. Time Yourself! We don't mind doing things as much if we know how long it takes to do them. Most cleaning takes no more than 10 minutes to complete. KPS is a big proponent of two minute sweeps. Take two minutes with a laundry basket to sweep each room, you'll be glad you did!
